1. Review of City Vision Statement – No changes were made to the Vision Statement.
2. Review of Council Goals – The Council agreed to make the following changes to the Council Goals:
  - Adding language to include production of products and services in the expansion of the Orting Business Community.
  - Updating Goal 2 to read: “Increase business revenues through increased local consumerism, tourism, and supporting ADR’s so that Orting remains a unique destination City.
  - Eliminating “establishing a regional committee of East Pierce County Cities,” due to lack of interest from other cities.
  - Moving the strategies of a north end meet and greet, the police department open house, and establishing information centers to Goal 5, Increasing Community Involvement.
  - Adding conservation of resources, deduction of inflow and infiltration and stormwater management to Goal 7, Maintaining Quality Utilities.
