**1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER, AND ROLL CALL**

Mayor Pestinger called the meeting to order at 5:00pm in the City Hall conference room.

**2. Approval of Ordinance No. 2017-1010, An Ordinance Of The City Of Orting, Washington, Amending Ordinance Nos. 2017-1006 And 2017-1009, And Orting Municipal Code Title 14, Chapter 1, Relating To Flood Planning Management And Flood Damage Prevention; Providing For Severability; And Declaring An Emergency**

City Attorney Charlotte Archer briefed the Council on the proposed ordinance. The City Council passed Ordinance No. 2017-1006 which amended Title 14 on February 22, 2017, at a regular meeting of the City Council. The Ordinance was sent to FEMA and the Department of Ecology for review. The deadline to receive approval to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program is March 7<sup>th</sup>. FEMA notified the City on February 27, 2017 that they had not approved the ordinance; according to FEMA the ordinance was lacking key elements. Those elements were addressed in Ordinance No. 2017-1009 and the checklist provided by FEMA was used as a guideline. The City Council voted on Ordinance 2017-1009 at a special meeting on March 1, 2017. On March 2, 2017, FEMA notified the City that they had not approved the ordinance for a second time. On March 3, 2017, the City submitted a draft of the proposed ordinance to FEMA and they approved it.


The City is seeking Council approval for Ordinance No. 2017-1010, which amends Title 14 and both ordinances 2017-1006, and 2017-1009.


