

## City of Orting, Washington Determination of Nonsignificance

**Description of Proposal:** The City of Orting proposes to amend its Shoreline Master Program (SMP) to ensure consistency with updated state laws and rules per the periodic review requirements of the Shoreline Management Act. The SMP sets forth policies, regulations and procedures regarding uses and activities within the city limits for those areas within shoreline jurisdiction.

**Proponent:** City of Orting

**Location:** Citywide, with a focus on shoreline jurisdiction areas of Orting, Pierce County, WA

**Lead Agency:** City of Orting

*Consistent with WAC 173-26-186(8)(b), which requires that this program includes policies and regulations designed to achieve no net loss of ecological functions, the City of Orting has determined that the amended Shoreline Master Program does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.*

This DNS is issued under 197-11-340(2). The lead agency will not act on this proposal for at least 15 days from the date of issuance, below. **Written comments on the DNS must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. March 15, 2019.**
