

## CITY OF ORTING WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 2020-34

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ORTING, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE CITY OF ORTING PARKS, TRAILS AND OPEN SPACE PLAN TO ADD A NEW POLICY.

WHEREAS, The City of Orting adopted the Parks, Trails and Open Space plan in 2003; and

WHEREAS, The City has updated the Parks, Trails and Open Space every six years since then to qualify for funding through the Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO); and

WHEREAS, The City Council desires to amend the Parks, Trails and Open Space Plan to add a single policy prioritizing barrier-free equipment; and

WHEREAS, Staff reviewed the amendment with RCO and confirmed that the plan can be amended as such prior to the six-year update; and

WHEREAS, The amendment was presented to the Parks Advisory Board and no objections were received; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing regarding the amendment on November 12, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the proposed amendment will not adversely affect the public health, safety, or general welfare and are in the best interest of the citizens of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORTING, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>PTOS, Chapter 1 Amended.</u> Orting Parks, Trails, and Open Space Plan, Chapter 1, Goals and Policies, Capital Facilities section is hereby amended as follows:

Policy 6.5 Future park plans or remodels should prioritize barrier-free equipment additions, such as wheelchair swings, adaptive spinners, or the like — where none currently exist.

<u>Section 3. Authorizes</u>. The Orting City Council authorizes staff to revise the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Plan.

<u>Section 4. Corrections</u>. The City Clerk and the codifiers of this resolution are authorized to make necessary clerical corrections to this resolution including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's errors, references, numbering, section/ subsection numbers and any references thereto.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption and signature as provided by law.
