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ORTING PARKS ADVISORY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER W/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE, AND ROLL CALL.

2. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Kim Agfalvi, Parks Board Secretary, presented pictures of a pump track submitted by Bobby Buechler. Mr. Buechler stated that he would like to see the City of Orting construct a pump track similar to the one in Leavenworth, Washington and provided pictures of design ideas for the Parks Advisory Board to consider.

3. OLD BUSINESS

A. Parks Plan Update

Emily Adams, City Planner, presented on survey results from the Parks Plan survey that was conducted. She presented a power point presentation on the level of service, existing demand, user satisfaction, national benchmarks, community benchmarks, considerations, and recommendations based on the parks survey taken and the level of service plan she developed.

Action: No action needed

B. BMX Park/Skate Park/Pump Track

Kim Agfalvi, Parks Board Secretary, briefed on the BMX Park/Skate Park/Pump Track. She stated that there has been no additional information received, and the Advisory Board asked that this item be added to the Parks Plan that Emily Adams, City Planner, is developing.

C. Gratzer Park Update

Kim Agfalvi, Parks Board Secretary, briefed on the Gratzer Park update. She stated that the project is currently on hold while they wait for new materials. She stated that they hope to re-start construction soon.

D. Pavement - Pave Parking Area in Main City Park

The Parks Advisory Board members stated that paving the main parking lot is still one of their top priorities and asked Emily Adams to include this item.

E. Town Gazebo

Refreshing the town gazebo was discussed and Kim Agfalvi, Parks Board Secretary, briefed that she had spoken with Public Works and a refresh of the gazebo is something that they are willing to take on.

F. Fountain upgrades in North Park

Mike Dannat briefed on upgrades discussed in previous years on the Parks Advisory Board. He stated ideas that were had were stamped concrete to replace the existing concrete and a half wall of concrete to replace the chain that is there now that would allow citizens to use it for sitting and enjoying the space.

Action: Work on getting a budget set up for stamped concrete and a concrete half wall where the chain is now located. Bring back to next meeting as agenda item on October 6, 2021.

G. Land Acquisition – Behind Hidden Lakes Development

Kim Agfalvi, Parks Board Secretary, briefed that there is no new news on the acquisition of land from Pierce County.

Action: Bring back to next meeting as agenda item on October 6, 2021.

H. Sign for ADA Spinner

Trudee Barfield briefed on the ADA spinner, and the confusion over what it does and how to use it. She stated there was a sticker on the spinner but that it had been ripped off.

Action: Ask Valley sign about ordering a sign that can be placed close to the spinner that details what the spinner is and how to use it. Bring back to next meeting as agenda item on October 6, 2021.

Trudee Barfield made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from July 7, 2021. Seconded by Mike Dannat. Motion passed (3-0).

4. PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT

Kim Agfalvi, Parks Board Secretary, briefed on Parks and Recreation activities. She stated the City will be offering a fall tot soccer season, along with a fall dance session. She stated that there would be approximately 6 tot soccer teams, and that registration for dance would begin after Labor Day.
