1. Call meeting to order and roll call.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm.

2. Public Comments.

No public comments.

3. Master Park Plan.

City Administrator Scott Larson briefed on the parks master plan for the Main City Park. He gave an overview of what the plan consists of, and how it would work. He stated the City is working through the process to scope out costs on what a park architect would be able to do for the City. He stated the City came in under budget on the Gratzer ballfield, and that he would recommend to Council that they reallocate the funds to hire an architect. He stated that accessible features for the park is one of the things wanted the most by Council. He also briefed that the City is working to get quotes on replacing the wood chips in the park with rubber play mats to make the areas more accessible for all.

4. Daffodil Festival.

Activities and Events Coordinator Michell Alfiere briefed on the Daffodil Festival. She stated that there will be vendors and food trucks in the main City Park the day of the parade. She stated that the City may be looking for volunteers for helping at the event and that the event would take place most of the day.

5. Old Business.

City Administrator Scott Larson briefed that the City may be able to gain an easement to the Puget Sound Energy property that is located behind Whitehawk, Village Green, and the middle school. He stated this would allow the City to start the process for building a trail for public use and that one of the original ideas was to utilize the trail for emergency access for schools. He stated that easement access would allow for trail improvements to be completed by the City and would allow the City to offer additional recreational space for citizens.

6. Parks and Recreation Report.

Activities and Events Coordinator Michell Alfiere briefed on all Parks and Recreation activities including painting classes, dance classes, tot soccer, fall soccer, fitness classes and crafty kids' class. She also briefed on the status of the Summer Experiences and Enrichment for Kids (SEEK) grant the City was awarded.
