### 3. Main Parks Master Park Plan RFQ review.

Scott Larson - The city received 5 responses to the RFQ – schedule is to notify shortlisted firms by Friday June 3rd, then interview June 10<sup>th</sup>, with the goal of presenting the suggested firm to city council at the Study Session June 15<sup>th</sup>.

4 interviews proposed – Scott suggested eliminating Board & Vellum from the running and moving forward with interviewing AHBL, MacLeod Reckord, Parametrix, and SCJ Alliance.

Thoughts from Park Advisory Board Members:

Trudee Barfield – Board and Vellum was at the bottom of her list.

Mike Dannat – bottom 2 are Board and Vellum and Parametrix. Top choice is MacLeod Reckord.

Board agreed to move forward with 4 interviews on Friday June 10<sup>th</sup> during morning hours. Michell will reach out to the 4 firms to schedule interviews, then contact board members with details once the interviews are scheduled.

## 4. Parks and Recreation Report.

Spring Tot Soccer – Last game June 13<sup>th</sup>. We would like to look into expanding the program to include kids up to ages 8-10 in the Fall. We would use the new multiuse field at Gratzer Park. Long term goal for soccer program would be to essentially replace the SGEO Recrecation program that used to be in Orting.
