RESOLUTION ORTING, OF THE **CITY** OF WASHINGTON, **MEMORALIZING** THE **CITY** ORTING'S AGREEMENT WITH WASHINGTON STATE  $\mathbf{OF}$ **TRANSPORTATION** DEPARTMENT AGENCY RELATED TO STATE ROUTE 162 ORTING **EMERGENCY EVACUATION BRIDGE SYSTEM** 

WHEREAS, the SR 162 Orting Emergency Evacuation Bridge System project supported by the Orting Bridge for Kids will provide a dedicated pedestrian evacuation crossing of SR 162 in the vicinity of the City of Orting school campuses; and

WHEREAS, the bridge will be the first link in an evacuation bridge system to evacuate people from the valley floor in the event of a Mt. Rainier Lahar. It will serve to provide a safe crossing of SR162 as a pathway to schools, improve transportation, reduce greenhouse gases and provide economic benefit to a city divided by a Highway; and

WHEREAS, the City desired to enter into a lead agency agreement with Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for funding of the SR 162 Orting Emergency Evacuation Bridge System project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council authorized the Mayor to enter into a lead agency agreement with Washington State Department of Transportation for the Orting Emergency Evacuation Bridge System project on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015 and the City Council would like to memorialize that vote;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORTING, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> By passage of this resolution memorializes that the City Council on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015 did by unanimous vote authorize the Mayor to enter into a lead agency agreement with WSDOT, in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.
