RE: 2023 Daily inmate Housing Rate Increase Notification

Dear Chief Gabreluk,

This letter shall serve as your official written notification that inmate housing rates for the Sunnyside Jail will increase for the upcoming year. The increase is due to price increases in meals and supplies.

The updated daily inmate housing rate shall be **\$57.00 per day**, effective January 1, 2023. No additional fees are added to the daily rate as indicated in the existing Interlocal Agreement.

The Sunnyside Jail is currently reopened to pre-COVID conditions with continuing screening protocols. We have been successful in limiting exposure to COVID-19 and have not had a positive COVID-19 case within general population in over two years. We will continue to monitor trends in the community and work with the Yakima County Department of Health to ensure the health and safety of inmates, which may cause our population limits to fluctuate.

Thank you for your continued partnership and we look forward to providing you affordable incarceration services to accommodate your future needs.
