AGENDA ITEMS

Approval of Prior Minutes

Update on Automated School Zone Enforcement

- Chief Gabreluk provided the committee with the results of a speed study that was conducted the week of April 22, 2024. The study highlighted traffic volumes per day/time, driving speeds and potential school zone violations. The committee was also provided with a sample city ordinance. This item was recommended to bring to study session for discussion purposes.

Emergency Management

AB24-XX EPIC-EM ILA Amendment (2A)

- The agenda item adds language that authorizes the City of Puyallup to make resource requests for emergency equipment/supplies with the County/State on behalf of other EPIC agencies during emergencies when requested. In addition, the town of South Prairie would be added to the ILA as member agency. It would add a data table to the ILA that updates cost sharing for each agency member. The committee moved this item to the next study session.

AB24-XX Adoption of EPIC-EM Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan

- Emergency Management representatives from each participating agency have created the EPIC-EM CEMP (Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan) which serves as a master document for emergency planning and response among agencies. The CEMP is to be adopted by each participating agency.

Pierce County Lahar Rapid Action Plan

- The Committee was provided the plan to review for future discussion.

Update on 2024 Department Goals

- Department command staff has highlighted the following areas as current goals: evaluating staffing needs and workloads, reviewing and updating current criminal code and being a full staffing levels.

Speed Display Signs

- Three signs have been ordered and will likely come before the end of the month.

Arrive Alive

- Orting Police Department participated in a multi-agency, safe and sober, driving presentation at Orting High School. The program provided the senior class with a realistic demonstration of what occurs when first responders arrive/respond to a vehicle collision. The program also included a discussion lead by a local DUI collision survivor.

AB24-XX SWAT ILA Addendum – Addition of SWAT Medics

- The committee was informed that our current interlocal tactical team would like to add SWAT medics. This item will be discussed in depth in upcoming meetings.

July Meeting Date

- Due to the 4th of July holiday, the committee will have its next meeting on June 27, 2024.

Monthly Statistics

- Chief Gabreluk provided the committee with the monthly crime statistics. The department responded to 416 calls for service during the month.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ORTING,
WASHINGTON, RELATING TO DESIGNATING CERTAIN
AREAS WITHIN THE CITY AS A “NEIGHBORHOOD
TRAFFIC SAFETY ZONE”; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF
AUTOMATED TRAFFIC SAFETY CAMERAS; ADOPTING
AMENDMENTS TO ORTING MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 7;
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Orting, Washington, has numerous school facilities located within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the geographic locations of Orting school facilities cause the existence of two vehicular school zones within the City; and

WHEREAS, a significant portion of school children who attend Orting Schools walk to school; and

WHEREAS, both school zones located within the City are bisected by SR-162, a major state route; and

WHEREAS, the City has observed an increase in the number of traffic collisions, traffic-complaints, and traffic-related injuries in these areas and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide a safe environment for school children while they travel to, and from, school facilities by enforcing traffic laws in these areas; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to automate the enforcement of school zone-related traffic violations to protect public health, safety, and the general welfare of its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Orting, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Amendments: Orting Municipal Code Title 7 Chapter 1 is hereby amended to the language included in Attachment A of this Ordinance.

Orting Municipal Code Title 7 Chapter 9 is hereby amended to the language included in Attachment B of this Ordinance.

Orting Municipal Code Title 7 is hereby amended to include a new chapter, titled “Chapter 7-12 – Neighborhood Traffic Safety Zones & Enforcement” included in Attachment C of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Corrections by City Clerk or Code Reviser. Upon approval of the City Attorney, the City Clerk, and the code reviser are authorized to make necessary corrections to this Ordinance, including the correction of clerical errors; references to other local, state, or federal laws, codes, rules, or regulations; or ordinance numbering and section/subsection numbering.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Transmittal to State. Pursuant to RCW 36.70A.106, a complete and accurate copy of this Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Department of Commerce within ten (10) days of adoption.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its approval, passage, and publication as required by law.

7-1-1: ORDINANCE ADOPTED:

A. Adopted By Reference: The "Washington model traffic ordinance", chapter 308-330 WAC, is hereby adopted by reference as the traffic ordinance of the city as if set forth in full. One copy of said model traffic ordinance shall be on file in the office of the city clerk.

B. Sections Not Adopted: The following sections of the MTO are not adopted by reference and are expressly deleted: WAC 308-330-255, 500, 505, 510, 515, 520, 525, 530, 535, and 540, all of which pertain to the licensing of bicycles.

C. WAC 308-330-423 is hereby amended as follows:

For State Route 162 from Milepost 10.31 to Milepost 10.34 the speed limit shall be 30 mph.

D. [RCW Chapter 46.63 – Disposition of traffic infractions is hereby adopted by reference.](#)

7-9-4: VIOLATION/PENALTIES:

~~Any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter shall have committed a parking infraction in violation of the model traffic ordinance of the city, and shall be subject to a maximum penalty of twenty five dollars (\$25.00). The provisions of section 308-330-720, 730 and 740 of the model traffic ordinance of the city, as now or hereinafter amended, shall apply to any such violation. (Ord. 879, 11-12-2009)~~

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, any person found to have committed an act designated a parking infraction under the provisions of this title shall be punished by a penalty of not more than \$145.00, not including statutory assessments or additional enhancements as required by law.

CHAPTER 7-12 - NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC SAFETY ZONES & ENFORCEMENT

7-12-1 DEFINITIONS

The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

"School" includes a school as defined by RCW 28A.150.010 or 28A.150.020, and includes a private school approved under RCW 28A.195.010.

"School bus" means a school bus as defined by the superintendent of public instruction by rule which is owned and operated by any school district and all school buses which are privately owned and operated under contract, or otherwise with any school district in the state for transportation of students. The term does not include buses operated by common carriers and the urban transportation of students, such as transportation of students through a city transportation system.

"School bus route stop" means a school bus stop as designated on maps or otherwise identified and submitted by school districts to the office of the superintendent of public instruction.

"Automated Traffic Safety Camera" means a device that uses a vehicle sensor installed to work in conjunction with an intersection traffic control system or a speed measuring device, and a camera synchronized to automatically record one or more sequenced photographs, microphotographs, or electronic images of the rear of a motor vehicle at the time the vehicle fails to stop when facing a steady red traffic control signal or exceeds a speed limit in a school zone as detected by a speed measuring device.

7-12-2 NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC SAFETY ZONE - DESIGNATED

The city council of the city of Orting, Washington, hereby designates an area within the city to be known as the "neighborhood traffic safety zone," which shall consist of all areas within the city within 1,000 feet of a school bus route stop designated by a school district, or within 1,000 feet of the perimeter of a school grounds. The actual penalty imposed for any traffic infraction committed within the area designated as the Orting neighborhood traffic safety zone shall not be less than 80 percent of the maximum, not including statutory assessments.

(1) It is not a defense to a prosecution for a violation of this Code, that a person was unaware that the prohibited conduct took place while in the Orting neighborhood traffic safety zone.

(2) It is not a defense to a prosecution for a violation of this Code that persons of under the age of 18 were not present in the area of the school, or at the school bus route stop at the time of the offense, or that school was not in session.

(3) In a prosecution under this section, a map produced or reproduced by the city for the purpose of depicting the location and boundary of the area within 1,000 feet of any property used for a school, or school bus route stop, or a true copy of such map under authentication, shall be admissible and shall constitute prima facie evidence of the location and boundaries of those areas; provided, however, the city council shall adopt a resolution approving the map as the official record of the location and boundaries of the area within 1,000 feet of the school and school bus route stops. The official map or a true copy of the map shall be filed with the city clerk and shall be maintained as the official record of the city of Orting. This section shall not be construed as precluding the prosecuting authority from introducing or relying upon any other evidence or testimony to establish any element of the violation. This section shall not be construed as precluding the use or admissibility of any map or diagram other than the one that has been approved by the city council if the map or diagram is otherwise admissible under court rule.

7-12-3 AUTHORITY FOR LOCAL USE OF AUTOMATED SAFETY CAMERAS

(1) Automated traffic safety cameras may be used to detect school speed zone violations. This section is intended to provide authorizing language as required under RCW 46.63.170.

(2) Use of automated traffic safety cameras is restricted to school speed zones only.

(3) Automated traffic safety cameras may only take pictures of the vehicle and vehicle license plate, and only while an infraction is occurring. The picture must not reveal the face of the driver or of passengers in the vehicle.

(4) All locations where an automated traffic safety camera is used must be clearly marked by placing signs in locations that clearly indicate to a driver that he or she is entering a zone where traffic laws are enforced by an automated traffic safety cameras. Markings notifying a driver of school zone enforcement cameras must be visible at least 30 days prior to the issuance of any penalties under this chapter.

(5) Nothing in this section prohibits a law enforcement officer from issuing a notice of traffic infraction to a person in control of a vehicle at the time a violation occurs under RCW 46.63.030(1)(a), (b), or (c).

(6) This section shall be applied as prescribed by RCW 46.63.170.

(7) Violations detected through the use of an automated traffic safety camera shall be issued with a monetary penalty equal to the same total penalty issued for such violations if detected by an officer without the use of an automated traffic safety camera, including the base penalty plus any statutory assessments authorized under state law, as set by the state supreme court, statute, or other court rule. However, in no case shall such penalties be issued in an amount that exceeds the amount of a fine that may be issued for an infraction involving a parking

violation and shall be processed in the same manner as a parking infraction. Such infractions may be issued with a penalty up to the maximum fines allowed for parking infractions, which are up to the amounts authorized pursuant to OMC 7-9-4 and OMC 7-12-5.

7-12-4 VIOLATIONS AS TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS

Failure to perform any act required or the performance of any act prohibited by this title or an equivalent administrative regulation relating to traffic, including parking, standing, stopping, and pedestrian offenses, is designated as a traffic infraction unless otherwise provided, except violations of 7-4 OMC, Bicycles, which are as provided therein.

7-12-5 MANDATORY MINIMUM PENALTIES

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, any person found to have committed an act designated a traffic infraction under the provisions of this chapter shall be punished by a penalty of not more than \$145.00; provided, however, where any law, rule, or statute provides for any maximum penalty, the actual penalty imposed for a traffic infraction committed within the area designated as the Orting neighborhood traffic safety zone shall not be less than 80 percent of the maximum, not including statutory assessments.

**ADDENDUM TO THE MASTER INTERLOCAL
COOPERATION AGREEMENT
FOR MULTIJURISDICTIONAL
SWAT TEAM**

This Addendum ("Addendum") to the aforementioned Master interlocal Agreement ("Master ILA") is entered into on this _____ day of _____ 2024, (the "Effective Date") by and between Central Pierce Fire & Rescue, located at 1015 39th Avenue SE, STE 120, Puyallup, WA 98374, hereinafter referred to as "CPFR," and the City of Orting, located at 104 Bridge Street South, Orting, WA 98360 hereinafter referred to as "CITY OF ORTING" who shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "Agencies" or singularly as an "Agency."

WHEREAS, incidents of a serious criminal or emergent nature often require medical care; and

WHEREAS, CPFR is interested in partnering with the CITY OF ORTING to deliver this level of care, during such incidents; and

WHEREAS, the Agencies recognize the benefits of cooperation and collaboration in delivering high-quality medical services to their communities and agree that joint use of the CPFR SWAT Medics will further that mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual promises contained herein and pursuant to the terms of the Master ILA, the Agencies hereby agree as follows:

1. PURPOSE

1.1 This addendum is aimed at enhancing the capabilities of the SWAT Team by incorporating Central Pierce Fire and Rescue (CPFR) SWAT Medics.

1.2 The primary objective is to provide timely and effective medical support during SWAT operations to ensure the safety and well-being of team members and civilians.

2. SCOPE OF COOPERATION

2.1 CPFR SWAT Medics will collaborate with existing SWAT team members to deliver advanced medical care in high-risk situations.

2.2 CPFR SWAT Medic involvement includes but is not limited to providing medical assessment, treatment, and evacuation of injured individuals during SWAT operations.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE AGENCIES

3.1 CPFR will provide comprehensive clinical training to SWAT Medics to ensure they possess the necessary skills and knowledge to operate effectively in tactical environments.

3.2 CPFR will supply essential equipment to ensure SWAT Medics are properly outfitted for their duties. This includes but is not limited to the following:

- 3.2.1 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Helmet, Body Armor, and Gas Mask.
- 3.2.2 Uniforms: CRYE Uniform.
- 3.2.3 Comms: Headset PTT.
- 3.2.4 Medical Equipment: Medic carry-bag

3.3 The Multi-Jurisdictional SWAT Team, in collaboration with CPFR, will maintain a calendar for scheduling purposes, ensuring optimal coverage during operations and training exercises.

3.4 The Everbridge system will be utilized for paging and notifications, ensuring swift and coordinated communication among team members and CPFR SWAT Medics during emergencies.

3.5 The Multi-Jurisdictional SWAT Team will be responsible for coordinating monthly training sessions, as well as the annual five-day summer training, the annual three-day training and the two-day training sessions held each month and providing the annual training plan to CPFR.

4. FISCAL ARRANGEMENTS

4.1 CPFR shall bear the financial burden associated with providing clinical training to SWAT Medics.

4.2 CPFR will also cover the costs of procuring and maintaining equipment such as PPE, Uniforms, and communication devices for SWAT Medics.

4.3 CPFR will be responsible for employee compensation during activations, training and other program required hours of work.

5. RESOURCE SHARING

5.1 The Agencies may explore opportunities for resource sharing, subject to availability, to support the SWAT Medic program. This may include sharing equipment, materials, and other necessary resources mutually agreed upon.

6. PERSONNEL

6.1 All SWAT Medic program personnel will be provided by CPFR.

6.2 The Puyallup Police Department Captain of Operations Division shall work with a designated representative from CPFR to ensure the SWAT medics perform and integrate in the SWAT team.

7. TERM AND TERMINATION

7.1 This Addendum shall commence on the Effective Date and shall remain in effect until terminated by either party.

7.2 Either Agency may terminate this Addendum by providing written notice of termination to the other Agency, with a notice period of 90 days prior to the intended termination date.

8. HOLD HARMLESS

8.1 CPFR will indemnify and hold harmless the police departments from any and all claims, suits, actions, or liability from injury or death of any person, or for loss or damage to property, that arises out of the activities performed while rendering medical aid and the police departments will indemnify and hold harmless CPFR from any and all claims, suits, actions, or liability from injury or death of any person, or for loss or damage to property, which arises out of the tactical activities while responding to incidents in which ORTING has primary jurisdiction.

9. PROVISIONS OF THE MASTER INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

9.1 Any terms not set forth herein shall be supplemented by the Master ILA, to the extent the Agencies are Agencies to the Master ILA. If any provision of this Addendum conflicts with a provision of the Master ILA, the offending provision shall be amended to conform to the terms of the Master ILA.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Agencies have caused this Addendum to be duly executed as of the Effective Date first above written.

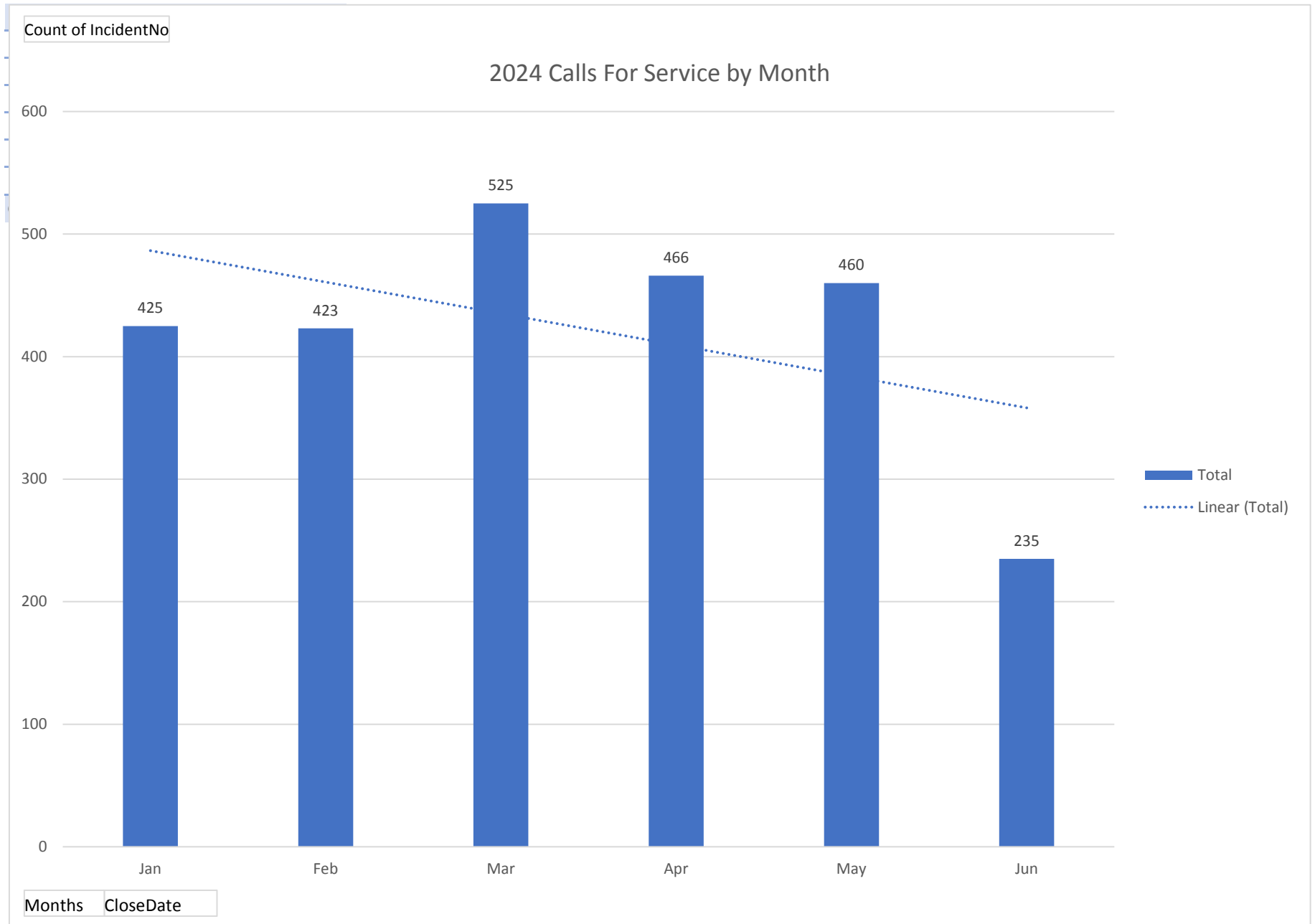
