# A. RV Code Amendments – Workshop

City Planner MillieAnne VanDevender gave a presentation for proposed code updates to OMC 10-14-3, 13-2-19, 13-4-2, and 13-5-3 regarding Recreational Vehicles. She stated code changes are needed if the City desires to allow occupancy outside of RV parks and to create a permitting process to allow short-term occupancy. Discussion topics included short-term occupancy, sewer connections, RV definition, and outdated terms and codes.

Planning Commission discussion followed.

City Planner MillieAnne VanDevender will prepare a final draft of the amended codes for another workshop at the June meeting and a public hearing will be held during the July Planning Commission meeting.

Co-Chair Craig made a motion to extend the meeting to 9pm. Seconded by Commissioner Pestinger.

### A. Dumpster Violations

### **B. Sign Code Violations**

The Planning Commission requested that The Wellness Shop, Jac's Brows, and Firehouse be reached out to about their unapproved signage. Tugboat Willy's signage issues have been resolved.

### C. Cargo Containers

Chair Cochran stated the orange cargo container located on Calistoga and Eldredge is only permitted with a minimum of five acres. City Administrator Scott Larson stated that Code Enforcement Officer Curt Ek has given the resident 30-days to remove the cargo container from their property. He stated that Business Solutions is utilizing an emergency storage and use container after they had a pipe burst.

#### 2. Report on Council Meetings.

City Administrator Scott Larson briefed the following highlights from the April Council Meetings:

- Safe parking discussion has been sent back to committee for further discussion.
- Council has been discussing RV code amendments and will continue the discussion once the Planning Commission has provided a recommendation.
- In March 2023 Council approved an additional 0.1% sales tax to be used for housing. Council approved the ECONorthwest scope and budget to conduct a needs assessment of our community to understand where these dollars would be best spent.

- The public safety committee is considering the addition of advisory speed signs throughout town and speed cameras in school zones.
- Council authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with Quigg Brothers for the pedestrian bridge construction over SR 162 at Rocky Road. Construction is anticipated to begin towards the end of summer.

The Planning Commission requested to bring back RV code amendments workshop and leave dumpsters and sign code violations under Old Business.
